NON-REFUNDABLE Enrollment Deposit--\$300: This deposit is part of the tuition and when paid, will be deducted from the total tuition. It is due upon enrollment or reenrollment for each student. **This deposit is Non-Refundable** and ensures a space at Central Florida Christian Academy in the appropriate grade for a student until June 1, 2012, when tuition payments (annual or monthly) become due. If tuition payments are not made as scheduled beginning June 1, 2012, the deposit may be forfeited and the student's place in the school may be awarded to another student at the school's discretion.

Curriculum Fees

All fees for 2012-2013 school year will be billed after March 1, 2012 for reenrolling students and are due by June 1, 2012, except as indicated below. Fees will be billed at the time of enrollment for new students and are due by August 1, 2012 or upon enrollment, if after August 1, 2012.

Curriculum Fee – Provides for classroom materials and classroom activities throughout the school year. All items purchased become property of CFCA and are non-refundable.

** Includes the additional costs for baccalaureate and graduation expenses and other materials, activities and functions specifically planned for seniors.*

Monthly Payment Service Charge-\$45 per family: This fee of \$45 *per family* covers the cost of setting up and processing tuition accounts when parents select a monthly payment schedule with FACTS Management. This fee is not assessed for accounts which are paid in full by June 1, 2012. After June 1, 2012 all accounts that have not already been paid in full will be assessed this fee, whether or not full payment is subsequently made. Any payments made in CFCA administrative offices are assessed a \$25.00 fee per transaction.

McKay Grant Processing Fee-\$395: For students enrolling in CFCA with a McKay grant. This fee offsets a portion of the added cost CFCA incurs for providing assessment, classroom accommodations, record keeping and other expenses on behalf of the student.

Other Charges/Fees – Mission trips, extended grade or class trips, college tours, service projects, retreats and other special functions and events that are not included in tuition may require additional fees. These activities are generally elective in nature, and the school will sometimes provide avenues of fundraising for students to earn a portion of these costs.

Payment of Tuition and Fees

Payment of the Enrollment Deposit is due at time of enrollment or reenrollment. A student will not be considered enrolled until this deposit is paid. Parents or guardians may choose to pay the tuition in full at the time of enrollment or in 10 or 12 monthly payments beginning June 1, 2012. Any funds received by the school under this Enrollment Agreement for any purpose whatsoever may, at the school's discretion, be retained by the school and applied toward any unpaid balances owed to the school for current or prior year's obligations and charges.



Extended Day Fees

Hours:

Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday 3:00pm to 6:00pm
Wednesday 2:30pm to 6:00pm
Half Days 12:00pm to 6:00pm

Full Day Program:

Cost: \$1800.00 per year.
The full day program covers extended day for all school days.

3 Day Program:

Cost: \$1100.00 per year.
The 3 day per week program covers any three days per week. If your child attends more than 3 days per week the fourth and fifth days are charged at the drop in rate.

2 Day Program:

Cost: \$750.00 per year.
The 2 day per week program covers any two days per week. If your child attends more than 2 days per week the third, fourth, and fifth days are charged at the drop in rate.

Drop in Program:

Cost: \$20.00 per day.
If your child is not registered in one of the above programs and your child attends extended day either prearranged or they were sent because of late pick up from car line you will be charged \$20 per day. This fee is incurred 10 minutes after normal start time.

Late Pick Up Fee:

Cost: \$1.00 per minute
If your child is picked up after 6:00pm from extended day each minute late you will be charged \$1.00.



2012-2013 Discounts

Church Member Discount Program – This discount is provided primarily to assist members of First Baptist Church Central Florida who have a financial need. It is the desire of CFCA to work closely to church members of FBCCF to have CFCA as their child's school.

- A 10% discount from base tuition will be applied per child attending CFCA.
- To be eligible for this discount BOTH of the following must apply:*
- At least one parent in a student's family must be a member in good standing of First Baptist Church Central Florida for at least 90 days prior to requesting the discount.
- At least one parent is enrolled and actively attending an adult Sunday School class.

*Families who request the Church Member Discount are stating that they are complying with these expectations.

If a student who has received this discount withdraws or is dismissed before the end of the school year, the amount of this discount will be reversed in determining the tuition and fees due for the portion of the year the student attended CFCA.

Kingdom Family Training Discount – This \$250 discount is a one time discount offered to all families for attending two of the following four Kingdom Family Training opportunities:

1. Kingdom Parenting 101 – Offered on Wednesday nights (8 sessions) at First Baptist Church Central Florida. (Where applicable both parents must attend)
2. Financial Peace University – Offered on Sunday nights (12 sessions) at First Baptist Church Central Florida. (Where applicable both parents must attend)
3. CFCA Family Orientation – Offered throughout the spring of 2012, the summer of 2012, and the fall of 2012. (Where applicable both parents must attend)
4. Parenting/Family Conference – Offered between June 1, 2012-May 31, 2013. This conference should be at least 8 hours in length and support Kingdom Education principles. (Where applicable both parents must attend)

* The discount will be applied at the completion of the conferences and may not be applied to the 2013-2014 school year.

* If a student who has received this discount withdraws or is dismissed before the end of the school year, the amount of this discount will be reversed in determining the tuition and fees due for the portion of the year the student attended CFCA.

Student Referral Discount – A \$250 discount will be applied to the tuition of any family that has referred a new student to CFCA and the new student is accepted and enrolled. The referred student must complete the application process, admissions interview process, be

working on grade level, be behaviorally mission appropriate and supportive of the school's Biblical Worldview. This discount will be applied once a new student has attended classes at CFCA. Student Referral Discount can only be claimed by one CFCA family and cannot be split among families. If a student who has received this discount withdraws or is dismissed before the end of the school year, the amount of this discount will be reversed in determining the tuition and fees due for the portion of the year the student attended CFCA.

Sibling Discount – This \$400 discount is available to each family with more than one student enrolled at CFCA. The oldest student will pay the full tuition and each additional sibling enrolled from the same family thereafter will be eligible to deduct \$400 from their total tuition (\$175 for Half-Day Pre-Kindergarten). Children must be siblings living in the same household with parents/guardians (except for court-ordered shared custody or guardianship arrangements) who are financially responsible for tuition in order to be eligible. If a student who has received this discount withdraws or is dismissed before the end of the school year, the amount of this discount will be reversed in determining the tuition and fees due for the portion of the year the student attended CFCA.

Full Payment Discount – Tuition accounts which are paid in full by June 1, 2012 will receive a tuition discount of \$200 (\$100 for Half-Day Pre-K students). In addition full payment waives the \$45 Monthly Payment Service Fee, so parents can save a total of \$245 or approximately 3% by paying in full. Annual payments must be received by June 1, 2012 for returning students or at the time of enrollment for new students to qualify for this discount. If a student who has received this discount withdraws or is dismissed before the end of the school year, the amount of this discount will be reversed in determining the tuition and fees due for the portion of the year the student attended CFCA.

Early Reenrollment Discount – Early reenrollment discounts vary upon the time the student reenrolls to CFCA. A currently enrolled family's tuition account for all children must be paid up to date in order to receive this discount for the 2011-2012 school year. If a student who has received this discount withdraws or is dismissed before the end of the school year, the amount of this discount will be reversed in determining the tuition and fees due for the portion of the year the student attended CFCA.

- A discount of \$500 for the oldest child and \$350 for each additional child in the same family will be applied for students who are reenrolled with enrollment deposits paid or postmarked by February 10, 2012.
- A discount of \$250 for the oldest child and \$150 for each additional child in the same family will be applied for students who are reenrolled with enrollment deposits paid or postmarked by February 24, 2012.



2012-2013 Tuition Assistance Program

Every child should have the opportunity to receive a **Kingdom Education**: a life-long, Bible-based, Christ-centered education that leads him to Christ, disciples him in Christ and equips him to serve Christ. In America today, getting a Kingdom Education for your children is not free, but it is the most precious thing you can give them. Unlike a secular education which only prepares a child for college or life, a Kingdom Education is for eternity. Since your child will live forever, shouldn't his/her education?

The real cost of a year at CFCA is actually considerably greater than the tuition paid by any family. The cost of tuition is actually underwritten by the generosity of many people, beginning with the members of First Baptist Church Central Florida who provide the facilities, upkeep and many other costs at a fraction of the real cost. Thus, every student is receiving tuition assistance to attend CFCA.

The tuition at CFCA is among the best values for parents in the Orlando community, especially for members of First Baptist Church Central Florida. Yet for a number of our families, it is still an unreachable challenge without assistance. In order to grant access to a Kingdom Education at CFCA for more families, the school began a Tuition Assistance Program. This program provides financial assistance to families who need help managing the tuition. To be considered for tuition assistance, a student must first apply to the school, be accepted for admission and pay the enrollment deposit. Current students must pay the reenrollment deposit. The family may then apply for financial assistance. All grants are awarded on the basis of the family's financial need as indicated by an independent third party assessment service and availability of funds for making grants.

It is our hope and desire that no family would fail to reenroll based solely on financial need. Therefore, CFCA encourages families and businesses that God has blessed to give to the CFCA Sponsor A Child Fund so that other families can attend. All gifts are tax-deductible.
